Yes, no later than 60 calendar days from the permit's effective date.

Initial fee when new NOI is submitted + annual fee when billed. Fees based on the acreage identified in the NOI.

Any Expected Changes with Permit Renewal:

None expected

Anything Interesting or Different than EPA MSGP?

AZ MSGP is split into two: industrial MSGP and mining MSGP

Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?

No, only upon request.

Visual Monitoring Required?

Two visual assessments during the summer wet season (June 1 - October 31) and two visual assessments during the winter wet season (November 1 - May 1).

Any other Monitoring Applicable to all Sources (not sector specific monitoring):

No, only sector specific monitoring applies

Minimum Inspection Frequency:

Quarterly

Annual Report / Due Date:

No, annual reports have been eliminated days from the permit's effective date

Training Frequency:

Annual
