

## INDIANA STORMWATER PERMIT QUICK FAQs

**Stormwater General Permit Issuance Date:**  
Varies by permit

**Expiration Date:**  
Varies by permit (5 year term)

**NOI Required to Continue Coverage:**

Yes, re-submit NOI 90 days prior to expiration.

**Fee Required / Fee Amount:**

\$50 application fee

**Any Expected Changes with Permit Renewal:**

In 2020, Indiana revised regulations for stormwater permit categories to be more consistent with federal permitting.

**Anything Interesting or Different than EPA MSGP?**

Several industrial sectors are included in Indiana's Rule 6, but not in the EPA's MSGP. Some examples are Tobacco products and the United States Postal Service

**Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?**

Three page checklist is submitted after plan is finalized, within 365 days of an NOI.

**Visual Monitoring Required?**

Yes, quarterly

**Any other Monitoring Applicable to all Sources (not sector specific monitoring):**

Sampling conducted annually or more frequently as specified in permit.

**Minimum Inspection Frequency:**

Annually or as specified in permit

**Annual Report / Due Date:**

Yes, within 30 days of sample analysis, and no longer than 365 days from previous submittal.

**Training Frequency:**

Annual

**Certification by Qualified Professional:**

Yes, responsible corporate official or duly authorized representative must certify the SWP3 checklist and annual report form.
