Yes, within 90 days of the effective date of new general permit per KYR00 Section 6.1.2

Fee Required / Fee Amount:

None for stormwater general permit per 401 KAR 5:310 Section 2.

Anything Interesting or Different than EPA MSGP?

Semi-annual stormwater sampling results are required to be submitted using netDMR. No specific requirements or benchmarking for industrial subsectors.

Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?

No, must be available during agency inspection and submitted to agency upon request.

Visual Monitoring Required?

Not required in KY general permit or factsheet. Facilities may monitor outfalls visually as best practice.

Any other Monitoring Applicable to all Sources (not sector specific monitoring):

Semi-annual stormwater sampling of flow, TSS, O&G, pH. Submitted via netDMR by 1/28 and 7/28 for proceeding 6 months.

Minimum Inspection Frequency:

Monthly

Annual Report / Due Date:

Stormwater Pollution Prevention Team shall conduct an annual site assessment and an inspection in response to storm events in excess of a 2-year, 24-hour event to verify the stability of the installed control measures and BMPs. Not required to be submitted

Training Frequency:

Not specified. Annual is suggested frequency.
