NOI Required to Continue Coverage:

Historically, those permittees authorized under the MSGP permit are automatically covered under the re-issued permit upon written notification from the LDEQ.

Fee Required / Fee Amount:

Annual fee \$109

No coverage for Sector AD – Facilities Not Covered Under Other Sectors and Designated by the Director

Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?

No, only upon request.

Visual Monitoring Required?

Yes, Quarterly

Any other Monitoring Applicable to all Sources (not sector specific monitoring):

The LDEQ may provide written notice to any facility requiring discharge sampling for specific parameter(s). Any such notice will briefly state the reasons for the monitoring, parameter(s) to be monitored, frequency and period of monitoring, sample types, and reporting requirements.

Minimum Inspection Frequency:

Quarterly

Annual Report / Due Date:

Once per calendar year. Not submitted.

Training Frequency:

Annual
