

## **MICHIGAN STORMWATER PERMIT QUICK FAQs**

**Stormwater General Permit Issuance Date:**

Varies by region

**Expiration Date:**

Vary by regions in Michigan

**NOI Required to Continue Coverage:**

Yes.

**Fee Required / Fee Amount:**

Yes - permit fees vary

**Any Expected Changes with Permit Renewal:**

Addition of Chlorides

Expect site specific permits (not general permits) to take +3 years to be renewed by the state after submittal

**Anything Interesting or Different than EPA MSGP?**

There are a number of general permits

**Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?**

Yes. Plan review and certification also required annually

**Visual Monitoring Required?**

Yes. Frequency is SWPPP and permit dependent.

**Any other Monitoring Applicable to all Sources (not sector specific monitoring):**

Monitoring requirements are industry and surface water source specific

**Minimum Inspection Frequency:**

Monthly

**Annual Report / Due Date:**

December 31<sup>st</sup>

**Training Frequency:**

Annual

**Certification by Qualified Professional:**

Yes. Every 4 years
