# Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?

Yes, facilities are required to submit a SWPPP with their application for first-time coverage and for continuing authorization. Must have SWPPP available on-site.

No, only sector-specific benchmark monitoring

#### **Minimum Inspection Frequency:**

Quarterly routine inspections and significant storm events inspections during or after significant storm events.
