

## OHIO STORMWATER PERMIT QUICK FAQs

**Stormwater General Permit Issuance Date:**

Issuance: 5/8/2017

Effective: 6/1/2017

**Expiration Date:**

5/31/2022

**NOI Required to Continue Coverage:**

Yes, likely 90 days after permittee receives notice from Ohio EPA on issuance of new permit.

**Fee Required / Fee Amount:**

Past NOI's have required a \$350 fee.

**Anything Interesting or Different than EPA MSGP?**

Ohio EPA's general permit aligns with the EPA MSGP.

**Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?**

No, only upon request.

**Visual Monitoring Required?**

Yes, quarterly

**Any other Monitoring Applicable to all Sources (not sector specific monitoring):**

Benchmark monitoring, annual effluent monitoring for specific activities based on effluent limitations guidelines.

**Minimum Inspection Frequency:**

Quarterly

**Annual Report / Due Date:**

Yes, using Ohio EPA provided Annual Reporting Form (Appendix I). Not required to submit unless requested.

**Training Frequency:**

Annual

**Certification by Qualified Professional:**

No, only RO certification is required.
