Generally, no. Requirements for a renewed NOI for a new permit are TBD.

Fee Required / Fee Amount:

Application \$100
Annual Fee \$347.71

Plan Required to Be Submitted to the Agency?

- Yes, if the facility falls under any of these:
- a. Located within a corridor/area of Federal and State sensitive waters and watersheds
 - b. Located in a watershed with an approved TMDL report or watershed plan in lieu of a TMDL
 - c. Operating under Sector J (Mineral Mining or Dressing) or Sector L (Landfills, Land Application Sites, and Open Dumps).

Visual Monitoring Required?

Yes, quarterly

Any other Monitoring Applicable to all Sources (not sector specific monitoring):

Sampling requirements for specific industry activities and for impaired waters

Minimum Inspection Frequency:

Quarterly

Annual Report / Due Date:

March 1st

Training Frequency:

Annual

Certification by Qualified Professional:

No, only RO certification is required.
